Essential Capabilities

- ◆ Previous experience handling & caring for dogs
- ◆ Ability to stand & walk unaided and use hands, arms, legs & feet.
- ◆ Average sense of vision, hearing, smell & speech
- ◆ Ability to bend, squat and maneuver in tight spaces
- ◆ Able to tolerate strong & unpleasant odors & loud & unexpected noises
- ◆ Retain knowledge of canine body language upon training

Volunteer Training

After attending Open House and applying to become a enrichment volunteer, volunteers will have online training and hands-on mentoring before able to volunteer.

Expect training to take 3-5 weeks, depending on your availability.
