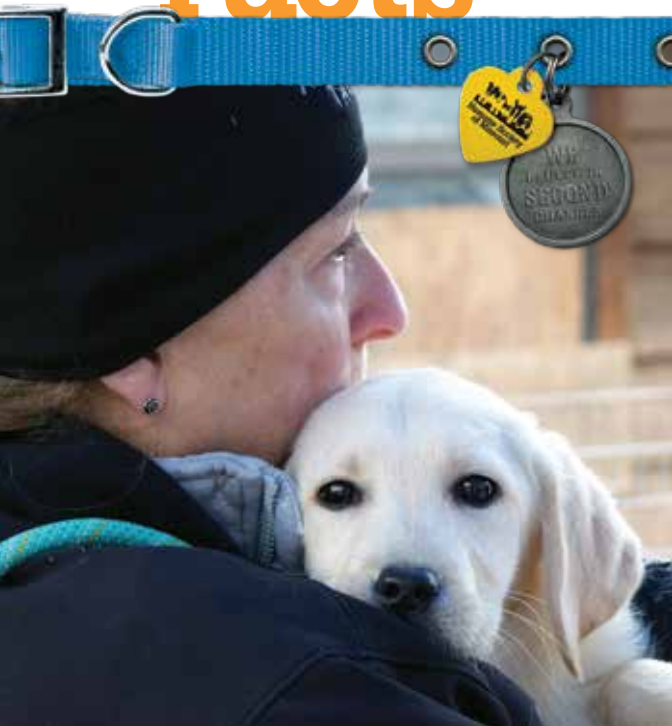


Furry 2024 Facts

In 2024...

the Humane Society of Missouri (HSMO) saw:

- All of our services, including the number of rescues, adoptions, Operation SNIP procedures and participants in our education programs increased.
- Costs increased with the need to hire additional staff and to replace or repair ACT's rescue vehicles.
- We began planning the expansion of our Best Buddy Center. Construction to add shelter capacity will start in 2025 and will cost more than \$5.5 million.

HSMO is the largest animal welfare organization in Missouri, and one of the largest in the country.

HSMO offers:

- Two open admission pet shelters in St. Louis City and Maryland Heights
- Longmeadow Rescue Ranch in Union, Missouri for rescued horses and farm animals
- Two nationally accredited veterinary medical centers called our Animal Medical Centers of Mid-America (AMCMA), both open to the public

HSMO relies on donations from generous individuals, corporations and foundations, and fees for services to provide second chances to animals in need. Private donations are vital to our mission, as we do not receive funding from national animal welfare organizations, tax dollars or the United Way.

Animal Rescue, Rehabilitation and Adoption



The Humane Society of Missouri accepts all animals that come to our doors. Our goal is to place 100% of adoptable animals, while providing veterinary care, enrichment and one-on-one attention to every animal in our care.

Longmeadow Rescue Ranch

This 165-acre ranch in Union, Missouri is one of the largest rescue, rehabilitation and adoption facilities in the U.S. for horses and farm animals. Longmeadow is a safe haven for abused and neglected horses and farm animals.

Animal Cruelty Task Force

On call 24/7/365, the ACT responds to reports of animal abuse, neglect, illness and injury in all 114 counties in Missouri.



Animal Disaster Response Team

For more than 50 years, HSMO has operated one of the largest animal rescue teams in the U.S. In times of need, the team provides animal rescue, including water rescue, sheltering and rehoming services in areas struck by disaster.



Humane Education

Respect for all living creatures is the message delivered to children and adults throughout the St. Louis metropolitan area. The curriculum is aligned with Missouri standards and is targeted toward underserved communities. Summer camps, fun activities and all programs are designed to promote empathy and kindness for all.

Animal Medical Center of Mid-America

Nationally accredited, the AMCMA provides veterinary services including comprehensive wellness services, diagnostics, surgery, dental, rehabilitation and spay/neuter procedures. Both of our centers include an Integrated Pain Management Center, complete with underwater treadmills to enhance healing. We strive to provide the best possible experience for patients and their families through individualized treatment plans, and all services are open to the public.
